

Guidance on standing for election to the European Parliament: European Parliamentary elections in Great Britain, 4 June 2009

Erratum

Disqualifications from standing as a party list candidate or individual candidate

In addition to the disqualifications set out in paragraphs 2.8-2.14 on pages 23-24, a candidate may only consent to being nominated as either an individual or a party list candidate in one electoral region in the UK at the European Parliamentary election on 4 June 2009.

Appointment of sub-agents

The following paragraph should be read in place of paragraph 1.55 (Sub-agents for registered political parties):

1.55 A party standing for election in more than one electoral region may appoint a sub-agent for the whole electoral region. They may, in addition or instead of, appoint sub-agents for a particular part of the same electoral region, e.g. to cover a local authority area. The extent of the area of appointment for those sub-agents appointed for particular parts of the electoral region may not overlap. Parties standing in only one electoral region may only appoint sub-agents for a particular part of the electoral region, e.g. to cover a local authority area. The extent of the area of appointment for those sub-agents may not overlap.

The following paragraph should be read in place of paragraph 1.67 (Sub-agents for individual candidates):

1.67 Sub-agents for an individual candidate can be appointed to act for a specified part of the electoral region, e.g. to cover a local authority area. The extent of the area of appointment for sub-agents of an individual candidate must not overlap: there cannot be two or more sub-agents for the same particular area. The sub-agent acts as the election agent for the area to which they are appointed.
