I am writing with regard to the Parish of Sheviock, in relation to the boundary review.

There are several distinct issues

1. Quethiock : Even if the Parish were to form a ward with St Germans and Deviock, (a proposal which the Parish Council does not support: see below) the inclusion of Quethiock is not supported. Quethiock parish is isolated to the North of St Germans, and should more properly be included with St Ive and Menheniot (Estimated Electorate of 3 parishes 3496). I believe Quethiock PC supports this view.
2. Deviock and St Germans; Whilst this grouping may look logical on a map, and may allow wards to the east and west to be more easily formed, in practice Deviock looks to Looe or Liskeard for services, with St Germans looking to Liskeard, whilst Sheviock, in common with the rest of the Rame Peninsula, accesses services in Torpoint. Bus infrastructure, and health services, are centred on Torpoint. It is strongly recommended by the Parish Council that the Parish is not linked with Deviock and St Germans, and I, as Ward Member, confirm that the grouping with Deviock and St Germans would be arbitrary and dysfunctional, and not a workable entity.
3. Rame Peninsula: The Sheviock Parish Council supports the inclusion of their parish with Antony, Millbrook, St John and Maker with Rame, which rely on Torpoint for services. However it acknowledges that this would create a ward with estimate of 3886 in 2012, which is outside the tolerance if 130 wards are to be created in Cornwall. However, if Torpoint is added then a total of 10171 electors would require 3 ward members for the wider Rame Peninsula, and it is requested, that with judicious warding of Antony (for example by adding Wilcove to Torpoint) and other parishes, single member wards could be created.

I, as Caradon DC Ward Member, agree that there are strong economic and administrative arguments for linking the Sheviock Parish with Torpoint, and I am writing to support their representations to you.

Please find attached my representation to the BC re proposal for warding in SE Cornwall A proposal has been submitted to make a ward of Deviock, Sheviock, St Germans and Quethiock, (pop3361)by, among others, Caradon DC.

I strongly suggest a ward is formed from Deviock, Sheviock, and St Germans (pop2984), and another with Quethiock St Ive and Menheniot combined (pop 3496).

Quethiock shares a large length of boundary with both St Ive and Menheniot, whilst having only a short common boundary with St Germans.

Geographically Quethiock would be isolated "out on a limb to the north" if combined with Deviock, Sheviock and St Germans .

If combined with St Ive and Menheniot it would be geographically and demographically a better option.

The above options are all within 6% tolerance The Chair and Vice Chair of Deviock, and other Parish Councillors, share my concerns, but cannot formally respond due to lack of time to convene a formal meeting.

The Clerk to Quethiock PC concurs with my reasoning, and is hoping to respond from that organisation.

Sheviock PC meets this Monday evening

I have been unable to contact the other PCs involved, but suggest it may be appropriate for you to consult with them before making draft recommendations
