I would like to congratulate you on your decision to stand as a candidate at the forthcoming local government elections.

We want our councils to be representative of the communities they serve. Over the last few years the Welsh Government has taken initiatives to encourage people from under-represented groups to stand for local government elections.

Every local authority is required to conduct a survey of candidates at each local government election so we can measure the progress being made although no candidate is obliged to provide any information.

For this election, the Local Government Data Unit ~ Wales (Data Unit Wales) will conduct the survey on behalf of local authorities in Wales. The data they collect will then be provided to each local authority and the Welsh Government. A report will be published based on the results.
