



Every British citizen who has been registered to vote in the UK within the past 15 years is still eligible to vote in some elections. You can vote by post, by proxy or in person (if you happen to have popped by).

A UK general election could be held at any time between now and June 2010 – so make sure you're registered to have your say in the UK.
