
## Re: Electoral review for the new Cornwall Unitary Authority

Thank you for your letter dated 5<sup>th</sup> March 2008 which was discussed at the last Parish Council meeting. I write to inform you that Gwinear-Gwithian Parish Council supports the principle that St Erth is a key partner in the Hayle Area Plan Partnership where an existing network not only already exists but has been proven in community regeneration management, this Council would oppose any suggestion that St Erth should be aligned with St Hilary and Germoe as the natural alliance is with that of Hayle, St Erth and Gwinear-Gwithian.

Can we confirm our agreement to the proposal that St Erth should continue to be seen as part of the Hayle, Gwinear-Gwithian and St Erth community and that this network should not be broken up by the formation of the new network areas by the new unitary authority.
