



Our offices in Cardiff are situated near the National Museum and City Hall.

By rail

From **Cardiff Central station**, cross over Central Square to join Wood Street. Turn right along this and proceed to the junction with St Mary Street. Turn left at the junction and proceed to the end of the street. At the junction with Castle Street, turn right. Proceed along Castle Street which merges with the pedestrianised Queen Street. Proceed along Queen Street until you reach Windsor Place on the left. Proceed along Windsor Place and cross over the pedestrian crossing into St Andrew's Crescent. Walk through St Andrew's Crescent, past Dewi Sant Church and you will see Caradog House in front of you.

From **Cardiff Queen Street**, turn right and proceed along Station Terrace until it merges with Dumfries Place. Follow the road around until it merges with Stuttgart Strasse, then after approximately 100 metres you will come to a pedestrian crossing. Turn right here into St Andrew's Crescent, past Dewi Sant Church and you will see Caradog House in front of you.

By bus

The nearest local bus stops are in Park Place and Dumfries Place.

By air

From **Cardiff International Airport** there is a rail link which connects directly to Cardiff Central station. From the station, to get to Caradog House, follow the directions shown above.

In addition, there is also the **X91 bus service**, which runs from the airport to Cardiff city centre (including Cardiff Central station). From the station, to get to Caradog House, follow the directions shown above.
