Review of Political Activities

Overview

The party has been inactive during the year with the exception of its web site which continues to enjoy a good readership. It has therefore been decided to deregister the party.

Membership

The party has a policy of two rates of subscription – individual members and couples – with concessions on the customary basis.

The party has no paid-up members at present not having collected subscriptions during the year. Existing memberships were renewed without charge pending a viable opportunity for resuming electoral activities.

Campaigning

The party undertook no campaign activity during the year excepting via its web site which continues to broadcast a viewpoint that appears to be almost completely abandoned in practical terms by the main parties – a belief that ever-growing government does not improve society and that a common culture and identity is something to be cherished not eroded.

The Freedom Party believes, however, that those critical of the direction being taken by the nation should maintain their position. Social control by the imposition of a system of imposed 'correct thinking' is not going to be everlasting.

Review of Financial Activities

Overview

The Freedom Party funded itself from notional income.

Change in basis

Due to the fall in income when compared with the results for 2005, the accruals basis for that year continues to be replaced by a receipts and payments basis. This is in accordance with guidance issued by the Electoral Commission concerning turnover and the reporting basis.

Receipts and Payments

Comparative figures are given for the previous year on a receipts and payments basis.

The party's costs were fully covered by notional income.
