Following the consultation meeting held at Shropshire County Council offices on Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2008, Mr Richard Thomas, Democratic Services Manager presented the draft proposal of the Boundary Committee for Shropshire.


He requested feedback from the parishes which would be considered by the Boundary Committee for England. Our Parish has been included in Map C21 in the current proposal but during discussions with Mr Thomas he agreed that our parish is an anomaly and the committee could not justify our position in C21 and would welcome any new proposal.

Historically we have always been linked with Atcham, Berrington and adjacent parishes on the east side of Shrewsbury, all relatively small and situated in rural locations. We therefore request that Withington Parish should be included in Map C22.

We feel that working with larger Parishes on the west side of Shrewsbury, who have very different needs and concerns, will adversely affect the community commitment in our parish which, through hard work and endeavour has been developed over the past six years.

We trust you will consider our request favourably as it is based on many years experience.
