### ERO guidance: update

Further to [Bulletin 269](#) and the publication of our [guidance to support the annual canvass](#), we have now begun the publication of the rest of our core ERO guidance in the new web-based format.

The first parts of the updated guidance – covering the role and responsibilities of EROs and the eligibility requirements for individuals to register, which previously appeared in Part 2 of our core suite of PDF guidance – can be found [here](#).

The substantive content of the guidance has not changed – it reflects the guidance provided in the previous PDF document, but with stylistic amendments to reflect the new more accessible approach and to improve navigation and presentation. The exception to this is that, where necessary, the guidance has also been updated to reflect the recent legislative changes relating to the franchise.

We will publish the remainder of the core ERO guidance in the new format on a rolling basis over the next two months, and will confirm to you when this work has been completed. In the meantime, you should continue to use the PDF guidance, which remains available on [our website](#).
