## Local government elections: guidance update

We have updated our local government elections guidance to reflect the changes made by [The Scottish Local Government Elections Amendment Order 2020](#) relating to the publication of candidates' home addresses on the notice of poll and ballot papers. These provisions come into effect on 9 September.

The updated guidance is contained within [Part C](#) of our guidance for Returning Officers and Parts [2a](#) and [2b](#) of our guidance for candidates and agents.

We have also published an updated [nomination pack](#) for local government elections, which includes a home address form that must be completed by all candidates.
