## Who is eligible to register to vote?

### You can register to vote if you are:

- Resident (usually live) in Scotland and aged 14 or over (but you will not be able to vote in Scottish Parliamentary or local council elections until you are 16. You will not be able to vote in UK Parliamentary elections until you are 18).

### You must also be either:

- A British or Irish citizen, or
- A Commonwealth citizen, or foreign national who has leave to enter or remain in the UK, or who does not require such leave.

## Privacy statement
