How many ELCOMM employees currently work from home and what percentage of the workforce is this ?

Our response is as follows:

We hold the information you have requested.

The Commission has a total of 196 employees, of which 32 (16.3%) are permanent homeworkers. However, all Commission employees are given the opportunity to work from home at least 3 days per week (if full time) as part of our hybrid working policy.

The Commission strives to be an open, transparent authority and I trust that this information satisfies your request.
