### Guidance for candidates and agents

We have now published updated guidance for candidates and agents at UK Parliamentary general elections in [Great Britain](#) and [Northern Ireland](#). The guidance, which is available in web-based, HTML format, reflects changes introduced by the Elections Act 2022, including the new commonly used name requirements, postal vote handling measures and the updated undue influence and intimidation offences.

Our guidance for candidates and agents for UK Parliamentary by-elections is still to be updated into HTML format. We expect this to be completed this month, and it continues to be available in PDF format in the interim.

The guidance also reflects changes to the spending limits for candidates at UK Parliamentary elections, which are now in force. As always, we will notify you through the Bulletin when any further updates to the guidance and additional resources are published.
