Ahead of polling day on Thursday, we wanted to take this opportunity to wish you all good luck for the next few days, and to thank you and your staff for your continued hard work to ensure that everyone will be able to cast their vote on 4 July, and that those votes are then counted in a way which delivers results that are accurate and can be trusted.

We recognise the significant challenges you have faced in preparing for this election, particularly given timing of the election, the short notice of the poll and coming in such close proximity to the PCC election in May.

A UK general election is, by its nature, high profile, and we know this impacts directly on your work, with increased media scrutiny and significant levels of interest in registering and voting creating administrative challenges that you have worked very hard to respond to.

We will be reporting on both the PCC and the UKGPE, including consideration of any areas where we think changes could usefully be made and we look forward to your feedback and support for that in the period after the election.

Meanwhile, we wish you well in managing the polls and the count.
